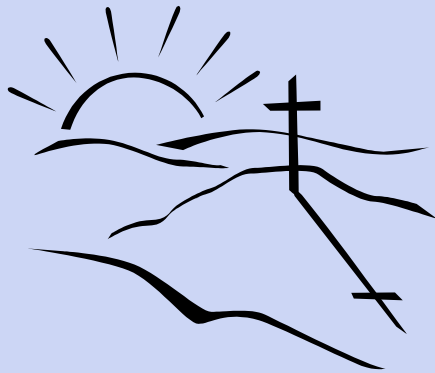

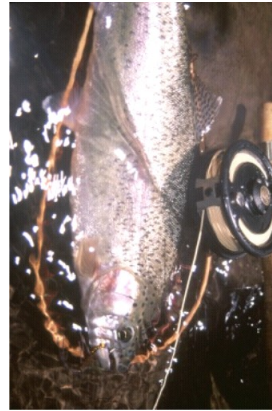

Fellowship

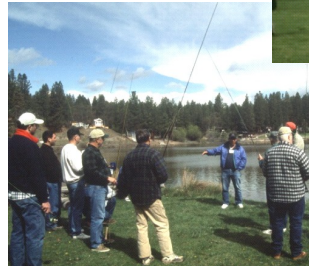
Christian Flyfishing Roundup is the weekend to be yourself. Past participants have found an honest environment free of the need to posture and protect.
